This inaugural conference brings together leading researchers and educational leaders in school policy, law, administration, curriculum and instruction to share findings on the future of public school magnet programs in light of recent court rulings, policy developments, and research findings.

Presentations will include, for example, the *importance of merging research on parents'* choice values and priorities against a map of racial and social segregation in urban school contexts as evidenced by the policies and practices utilized by magnet school directors in five illustrative and regionally distinct districts. Another addresses the implementation of curriculum and instructional practices that are responsive to the needs of culturally and linguistically diverse student populations
