* Collaborative work

* Community discussions and education

*Research and training

PARCEO engages in research and training that support and strengthen the ongoing work of parents and education groups and community organizations.

PAR emphasizes the centrality and importance of people's and communities' own voices and leadership--rooted in our histories, cultures, wisdom, and experience--as we engage in research and organize collectively for social change.

PAR is an interactive, respectful, and inclusive community process in which all who are engaged are teachers and learners.

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
